PARISH NEWS REFLECTION -

1 John 5:1-12 "Faith, Love and Obedience"

Many people struggle with what we call assurance. It has to do with the surety we have about our relationship with God and our salvation. How can we be sure that God has accepted us and forgiven us? How can we be sure that we will inherit eternal life and go to be with God?

People often wonder if they have done enough good in this life to deserve heaven. They wonder if they have been religious enough. The truth is, it has nothing to do with how much good we have done, or even how religious we might have been. It has to do with faith in Jesus Christ.

We read in today's bible Reading from 1 John chapter 5, vs. 1 that "everyone that believes that Jesus is the messiah is born of God". Here is an outline of this morning's sermon.

- 2. Three testimonies that prove that Jesus Christ comes from God (6-10)

- c. The Spirit of God
- 3. Three benefits of our Faith in Jesus Christ
- a. We have become children of God (1)
- b. We have victory over the world (4-5)
- c. We receive the gift of eternal life (11-12)
